Payment

For January Term programs, the following schedule applies:

- 100% of billable tuition and program fees due 30 days prior to On-Grounds Term Start
- 100% of billable airfare due 10 days from date of registration (Billable airfare is Non-Refundable)

Billable Fees* include:

- Tuition for courses described in brochure
- Double Occupancy in centrally located hotel including daily breakfasts
- Some group lunches and dinners
- Navigo/Metro passes
- Day trip to Villequier; lunch will be provided
- Ground Transportation during day trip
- One Theater event (subject to availability)
- Admission fees to program-required cultural and historical sites
- Health and Emergency Assistance Insurance through CISI. **The ISO will enroll students in the insurance policy for the program dates.**

Note regarding group meals:

Every effort will be made to accommodate dietary restrictions during group meals; however, all countries have distinct cuisines along with food preparation techniques, and it is not always possible to address specific food concerns and meet needs. Program participants are responsible for ensuring their needs can be met for their chosen program itinerary.

Non-billable Expenses:

Non-billable items posted above are **estimates** and will differ for each individual depending on their personal needs, course requirements, and personal choices. Fluctuations in international currency will affect total expenditures. The cost of airfare will be affected by availability and routing.

- Round-Trip airfare to program destination (estimate based on fares provided online in June, 2018, with departure from Dulles International Airport (IAD) arriving Paris (CDG))
- Airport transfers (transportation between your home and/or hotel and airports)
- Most Meals (non-billable meals estimated on average of \$39 [EUR 32] per day)
- Phone Service
- Entry fees to non-compulsory site visits
- Health and Emergency insurance coverage beyond program dates
- Course materials
- Laundry

Other Expenses to consider:

There are possible costs that have not been included in this budget because they may not be applicable to all students, and will differ by individual if applicable. These may include but are not limited to:

- Personal travel beyond the scope of the program
- Immunizations for the area of travel
- Visa fees (non-U.S. citizens) Visa fees and regulations are subject to change
- Passport fees
